



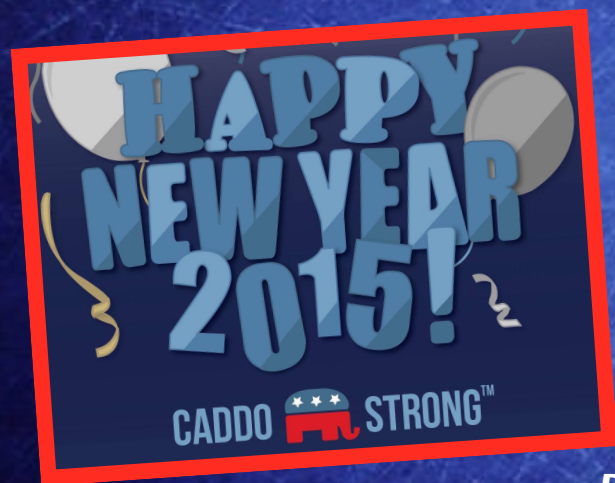

Caddo Parish School Pitches \$108 million in Bonds to Voters, but Promises No “New” Taxes

THIS MONTH’S MEETING

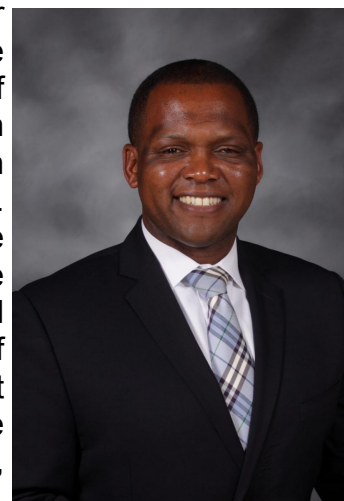
Speaker for this month’s luncheon at **12 noon on Tuesday, January 6, 2014** at the Wyndam Garden Hotel (formerly the Clarion Hotel) on E. 70th Street will be **the Dr. Theodis Lamar Goree, Jr.**, the superintendent of Caddo Parish Schools.

There are a number of issues before the CPSB in 2015. The Shreveport Times recently reported that Caddo School officials discussed neighborhoods for new schools, and outlined a millage tax rededication proposal to resize the district and provide upgrades. The proposal, set to go before the school board in January, calls for the closure of six schools. Three new schools would be built under the plan. A new school proposed for southeast Shreveport would house kindergarten through eighth-grade.

The proposal is a call for the rededication of an existing millage tax and will not cost

residents additional money, according to Goree. “Let me be clear when I say we will not raise taxes. It was important to us that we did not ask families to spend any additional monies,” he said.

Dr. Theodis Lamar Goree, Jr. became superintendent of Caddo Parish Public Schools in October of 2013. He believes the collaborative efforts of all stakeholders are of paramount importance as we invest in the future, our children.

THINGS THAT MAKE YOU SAY...

Elliott Stonecipher recently pointed out that Caddo Commissioners have had their salaries raised 165% since 1993. It was \$8,400 a year in 1993, and today that salary amount is \$22,263.

However, if Commissioners had used actual cost-of-living adjustments, as determined by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, their pay today should be \$13,385 per year (instead of the \$22,263 they are receiving). All non-term limited Commissioners are up for re-election in Fall 2015.
